„EARLY LEARN TO LEARN ENVIRONMENT (EL2LE)“

The project "EARLY LEARN TO LEARN ENVIRONMENT (EL2LE)", which is being implemented as part of the Erasmus+ KA2 program, is a joint cooperation of preschools from Turkey, Croatia, Belgium, Latvia and Greece, institution for quality measurements from Finland and University from Sweden, during the period from 01.09.2014 - 31.09.2016.

The project is intended for preschool children 3-7 years old and is carried out with the aim of encouraging the development of learning skills using natural materials. In the project, until now, 60 activities have been designed and carried out in five preschools in Turkey, Belgium, Greece, Croatia and Latvia. Activities with children are carried out according to PBL (problem based learning) method, which focuses on child-oriented environment and active learning.
